Schools supplies needed for Colors 4 Kids

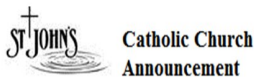

FIELD DAY DRESS CODE

Kindergarten through 8th grade

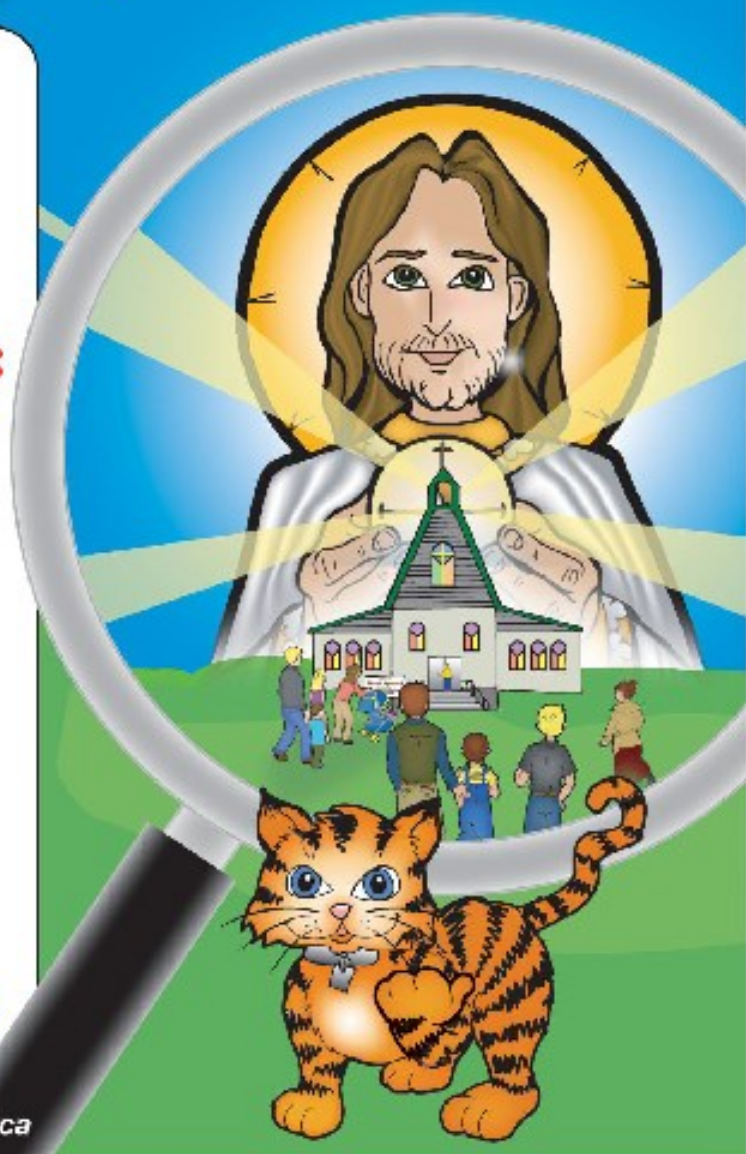
