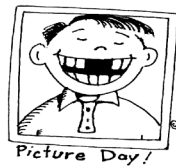

Box Tops News: Another school year is upon us and we are gearing up for a record year for our Box Tops Program. Every Box Top is worth 10 cents and those add up very quickly. Last year we collected over 38,000 Box Tops and that meant we earned over \$3,800 for St. John's! A list of participating products can be found on Renweb under the School Resources tab. You can send in your Box Tops at any time with your child as each classroom has their own collection bag. The top 3 classrooms that bring in the most Box Tops each quarter will receive a classroom reward. Remember, Box Tops do have expiration dates on them. If they have expired, just like a coupon, we can not turn them in for reimbursement. So, the quicker you turn them in, the better. Thank you for your support!

Coke Rewards: St. John's is participating in the Coke Reward Program again this year. Send in your bottle caps as well as codes from any 12,20 or 24 pack of coke products including Dasani water multi packs and Powerade. The codes are found on the inside of the cardboard packs of soda and under the bottom of the plastic wrap of cases of Dasani water.

Tyson Rewards: Tyson Rewards is another program St. John's participates in. Send in labels from participating Tyson products including frozen bags and boxes of chicken products. We earn 24 cents from each label. Another great way to earn money for our school!
