Band Policies

Every band student is expected to:

- 1. Attend every rehearsal
- 2. Be Prepared for rehearsal (Instrument, Book, Pencil, Folder, Valve Oil/2 Reeds/Cork Grease at your **seat on time**)
- 3. Practice AT LEAST 1 hour a week
- 4. Participate in EVERY performance and dress rehearsal

Classroom Procedures

Every band student is expected to:

- 1. Be in your chair with your instrument, music and supplies ready to rehearse at 3:05 or 7:15am.
- 2. Remain seated for the entire duration of band. Visit the restroom **before** coming.
- 3. Absolutely **NO** talking or playing unless asked to do so.
- 4. No food or drinks immediately before playing
- 5. Follow all school rules, even while on breaks from rehearsal, this includes using inside voices.
- 6. Practice 1 hour a week.
- 7. Failure to meet goals (such as scales) might result in an additional guided rehearsal time.

Disciplinary Procedures

Each student is expected to follow band rehearsal rules as outlined here and as posted on the wall. Failure to do so will result in the following consequences:

1st Offense: Verbal Warning

2nd Offense: In-Class Written Assignment

3rd Offense: Temporary Suspension/Silent Lunch

4th Offense: Conference with band director, student, and parents

Field Trips

Typically, advanced band members will have several opportunities throughout the year for performances outside of the school. All forms must be turned in promptly. All school rules apply. Misbehavior on trips, such as disruption and not following instructions is not tolerated.

1st Offense: Verbal Warning

2nd Offense: Sitting out of activity

3rd Offense: Conference will be scheduled, and student will be removed from trip.
