The Four Candles of Advent

represent the four Sundays of Advent, and they symbolize hope, peace, joy, and love.

Week 1: Purple Advent
Candle, Hope: In the first
week of Advent, just like the

Prophet Isaiah, we anticipate the birth of Jesus and the arrival of the Messiah.

Week 2: Purple Advent Candle, Faith: This candle symbolizes the journey of Joseph and Mary to Bethlehem. It calls you to prepare the way of the Lord.

Week 3: Pink Advent Candle, Joy: This candle reminds us that Jesus coming is near and the joy that the world experienced at the birth of Jesus. This is the middle point of Advent, also known as Gaudete (Latin word for Rejoice) Sunday.

Week 4: Purple Advent Candle, Peace: The final week of prayer and penance as we wait for the birth of our Savior. It reminds us of the message of the angels: "Peace on Earth, Good Will Toward Men."

Advent does not stop with the lighting of candles on the wreath every Sunday at Mass. As Catholics, we should give extra by incorporating the joy of Advent in our daily lives.
