- 500 awards for students with special needs
- Dependents of active-duty service members who are zoned for a priority school

## → Eligibility for 2027-2028 and Beyond\*

- All families can apply regardless of adjusted gross income
- 500 awards for students with special needs
- Dependents of active-duty service members who are zoned for a priority school

**\*Priority given to previously participating students and their siblings**

**Please note: Students who currently receive a scholarship through AAA are not eligible for an ESA**
