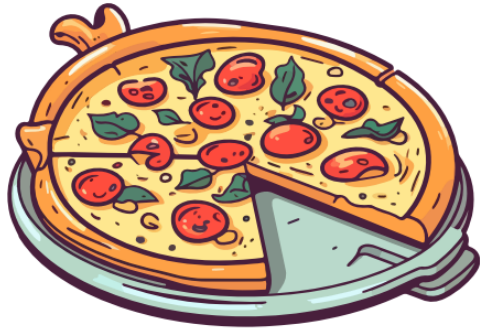

The CHOOSE Act Application opens January 2, 2025, at 7:00 AM!

Qualifying students who enroll in or currently attend Diocese of Birmingham Catholic schools can receive **up to \$7,000** a year for tuition, certain fees, and other eligible expenses.

→ Eligibility for 2025-2026 and 2026-2027*

- Students whose family's adjusted gross income from the preceding tax year does not exceed 300% of the poverty level
- 500 awards for students with special needs
- Dependents of active-duty service members who are zoned for a priority school

→ Eligibility for 2027-2028 and Beyond*

- All families can apply regardless of adjusted gross income
- 500 awards for students with special needs
- Dependents of active-duty service members who are zoned for a priority school

***Priority given to previously participating students and their siblings**

Please note: Students who currently receive a scholarship through AAA are not eligible for an ESA
