SPORTS for the 2020-2021 school year. St. John's is considering participating in a modified sports season through our league, the HISL. As you know, we manage sports for 6th grade and below here and have been in consultation with the league. At this point, we are considering a modified season as follows:

Basketball - January (grades 3-6)

Volleyball (grades 5-6 girls) and Outdoor Soccer (grades K4-6th) - March/April

Track and Field (grades 5-6) - April and early May

Obviously, should we have a rise in COVID cases, we would suspend seasons/teams as needed. We will hold sign ups prior to each sport to determine if we have enough interest. The sign up periods will be brief. We will make team decisions based on sign up so you will need to respond within the window offered.
